Dear Parent

For the last 2 weeks, following the government directive for the wider opening of schools, we have had more pupils back in school from years Reception, Year 1 and Year 6, along with more Key Worker students.

To maximise safety of all stakeholders, procedures in school are constantly being reviewed and updated where necessary. With numbers of pupils rising, new decisions have had to be made and original risk assessments reviewed and updated accordingly.

The risk assessment at Selattyn includes social distancing as one of the measures put in place to limit the spread of infection. This has an effect on the number of pupils that can safely be admitted in to each class base.

This week has gone well with staff working tirelessly to make sure all risk assessed measures are kept in place, and all procedures and systems work smoothly. The children themselves have been fantastic and made our job so much easier. They have been sensible and listened carefully to any new rules. They have just been children accepted things have changed, and got on with what they have had to do! Ms Morgan and staff are very proud of each and every one of them.

As the weeks begin to tick by, there are still many uncertainties and areas where we just do not have all the answers. Ms Morgan continues to cascade information received from the government and Local Authority updates and directives to staff, governors and yourselves, where necessary.

We are aware that many families will have mixed emotions following the government announcement this week that pupils from other year groups will not return to school until the autumn term.

As always, Ms Morgan is happy to chat around areas of concern or worry, on the telephone, should they arise and knows that this time continues to be an anxious period for everyone. She is teaching every day in Class 4M, except for Thursday afternoons, but office staff will be happy to organise a convenient time for her to phone should you need to discuss an issue or a worry.

Ms Morgan and staff would like to thank all those pupils and parents who have brought in delicious homemade biscuits and written letters/cards to keep them informed of what they have been doing. Going forward, we would welcome pupils' accounts of activities undertaken at home.
